James Akroy & Others Application hath been made
unto to Grant Certificates that certain tracts
of Land containing Twenty three and five
hundred acres are not included within the
Green Mountains, which said tracts of
Land are situate lying and being on the
Harbours of Newburg and LaSallegruch -
within the County of Cumberland, and
are situated and bounded as follows: Beginning
at a white mark in the North side the River
that empties into LaSallegruch Harbour
thence to run North One hundred and two
chains, thence North twenty degrees west
twenty chains, thence North fifty nine
degrees west six hundred and sixty three
chains, or until it comes to the Western
Angle of James Fells Lot N^o 106. thence
North forty five degrees east, twenty one
chains.
