- Nominees will be individuals who have gone "*that extra mile*" with their contributions to the United Empire Loyalists' Association of Canada.
- Nomination(s) of the recipient(s) for the UELAC Dorchester Award to be nominated at the Branch or Dominion level.
- Nomination(s) to be submitted to UELAC Dorchester Award Committees' Chair by end of February yearly.
- Award(s) to be presented annually, if said nominations are in place, at the UELAC Annual Conference by the present UELAC Dominion President or his/her designate and assisted by the UELAC Senior Vice President.
