Genealogical Proof Argument Generation 5:

To show that William Purdy Munro is the son of Huldah Purdy Munro

1. Marriage Records of Rev. William Jenkins of Richmond Hill, show marriage of Timothy Monro [sic] and Hulda Purdy, 10 Sep 1824. (Please see Generation 6, item 6.8, for proofs)
2. Last Will and Testament of Timothy Munro, page 1, naming William P Munro as his son. (Please see Generation 6, item 6.11, for proofs)
3. Commemorative Biographical Record, printed in 1907, page 293-4, biography of William Purdy Munro, naming him as son of Timothy and Huldah (Purdy) Munro. (Please see Generation 6, item 6.12 for proofs)
4. Tombstone of William Purdy Munro, Mount Pleasant Cemetery, Toronto, ON, shows a traditional naming pattern, a son named after his maternal grandfather. (Please see Generation 6, item 6.13, for proofs)

Therefore William Purdy Munro is the son of Huldah Purdy Munro.

Genealogical Proof Argument, Generation 6:

To show that Huldah Purdy Munro (1803-1828) is the daughter of William Purdy:

1. William Purdy (1769-1847) is the son of Jesse Purdy, UE (1749-1817), as shown on his UCLP and the will of Jesse Purdy. (Please see Gen. 7 for proofs)
2. A biography of William Purdy by Elwood Jones, states that he had lived in Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu, that he had received a land grant in Yonge Twp., Leeds Co, and that he then moved to Vaughan Twp, York Co. This biography also names two of his eleven children, his sons Hazzard Wilcox and Jesse Thomas. (http://www.biographi.ca/en/bio/purdy_william_7E.html)
3. The petition of Mrs. Catherine Proctor, daughter of Catherine Leech (1749-1811), widow, shows that the Munro family escaped from Crown Point across Lake Champlain to "St. John's in the Lower Province", i.e. Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu, and settled in the Township of Yonge. (p. 3 & 4 of petition). (Upper Canada Land Petitions "P" Bundle 8, 1806-1808 (RG1, L 3, Vol. 402), Film C2490, petition #50, pp 233-238)
4. Daniel Munro (1774-1811) in his UCLP states that he is the son of Catherine Leech and thus he would be a contemporary of William Purdy, both sons of Loyalists. (Upper Canada Land Petitions "M" Bundle 9, 1808-1810 (RG1, L 3, Vol. 334), Film C2196, petition #62, pp 733-736)
5. William Purdy, Daniel Munro and Catherine Leech (now Golden) are all shown on the 1802 and 1803 censuses for Yonge Twp. (District of Johnstown, 1802 census and 1803 census; District of Johnstown fonds, F1721, microfilm MS 2554, Archives of Ontario, Toronto.)
6. Timothy Munro of Markham (1803-1892), applied for land as the son of Daniel of Yonge. (Upper Canada Land Petitions "M" Bundle 20, 1837 (RG1, L 3, Vol. 363), Film C2218, petition 125, pp 341-2)
7. Thus both the Munro and Purdy families were UE, they travelled through Saint-Jean-sur-Richelieu, settled in Yonge Twp, and later lived near each other, Munro in Markham Twp, Purdy in Vaughan Twp
8. Marriage Records of Rev. William Jenkins of Richmond Hill, show the marriage of Timothy Monro [sic] and Hulda Purdy, 10 Sep 1824; naming Jesse Purdy as witness. (Archives of Ontario Microfilm Reference F 982, Richmond Hill, 1822-1823 Marriage records, Rev. William Jenkins, MS 7588)
9. Scan of handwritten bible pages listing the children of William Purdy, including Huldah, Hazzard and Jesse, received from Edmonton Branch, UELAC, in Dec. 2015. Transcript attached.
10. The Land Book record for Ops Twp, Newcastle District, shows Lot 21 Conc 6 being transferred from William Purdy to Hazzard W, and Jesse T. Therefore, Jesse Purdy is again shown to be a son of William Purdy and therefore a brother to Huldah Purdy. (www.onland.ca/ui/57/books/68798/viewer/456276770?page=191)
11. Last Will and Testament of Timothy Munro names William P Munro as his son. (As printed at the Archives of Ontario in 2008)
12. Commemorative Biographical Record, printed in 1907, page 293-4, biography of William Purdy Munro, naming him as son of Timothy and Huldah (Purdy) Munro. (As given to me by a cousin)

In the name of God, Amen, I Jesse Purdy of Elizabethtown, County of Leeds, district of Johnstown, and Province of Upper Canada, being at present sick and weak in Body, but thanks be to God, of perfect mind and memory, do make and ordain this my last will and Testament, in manner and form following, that is to say, firstly I recommend my soul to Almighty God who gave it, secondly, I commit my Body to the earth, in decent Christian Burial at the discretion of executors, nothing doubting but at the last day it will again be raised. As touching what worldly property I am at present possessed of, I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Ruth, one half of all my estate both real and personal, during the time she remaineth my widow, and in case of marriage one third of all my property both real and personal (the true meaning of which is in case of her marriage, to have the Use of one third of said property) and at her decease the whole of said property to be given to my son Thomas Purdy; of which the other half after my wife's, at present is to be given to the said Thomas. I give and bequeath to my beloved son William Purdy, the sum of five pounds H. Cy out of said estate, before the division is made between my wife Ruth and son Thomas.

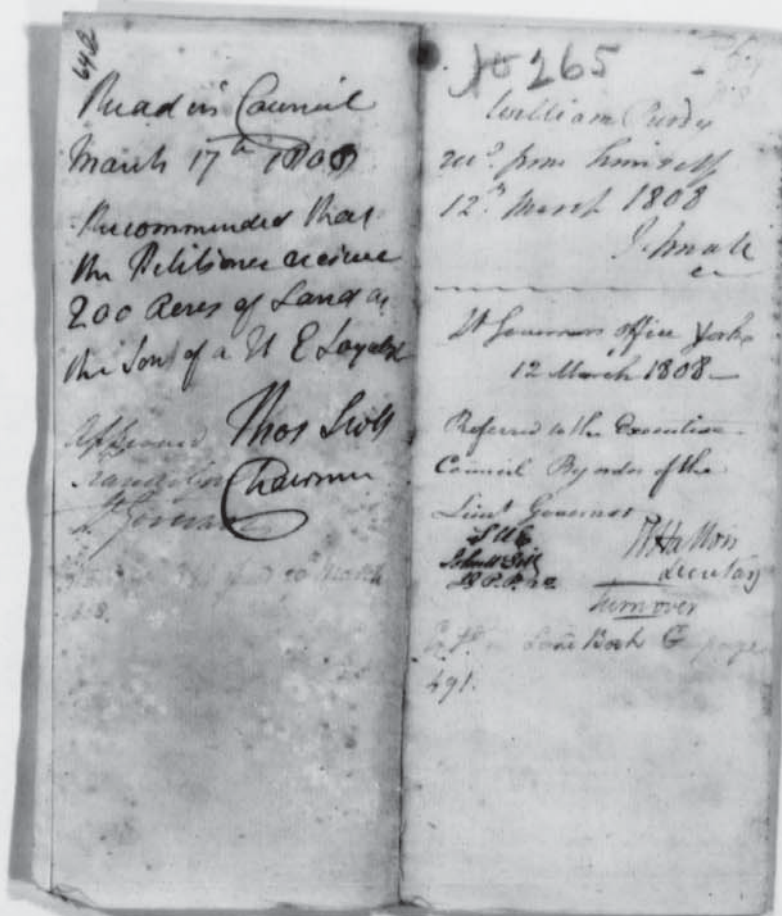

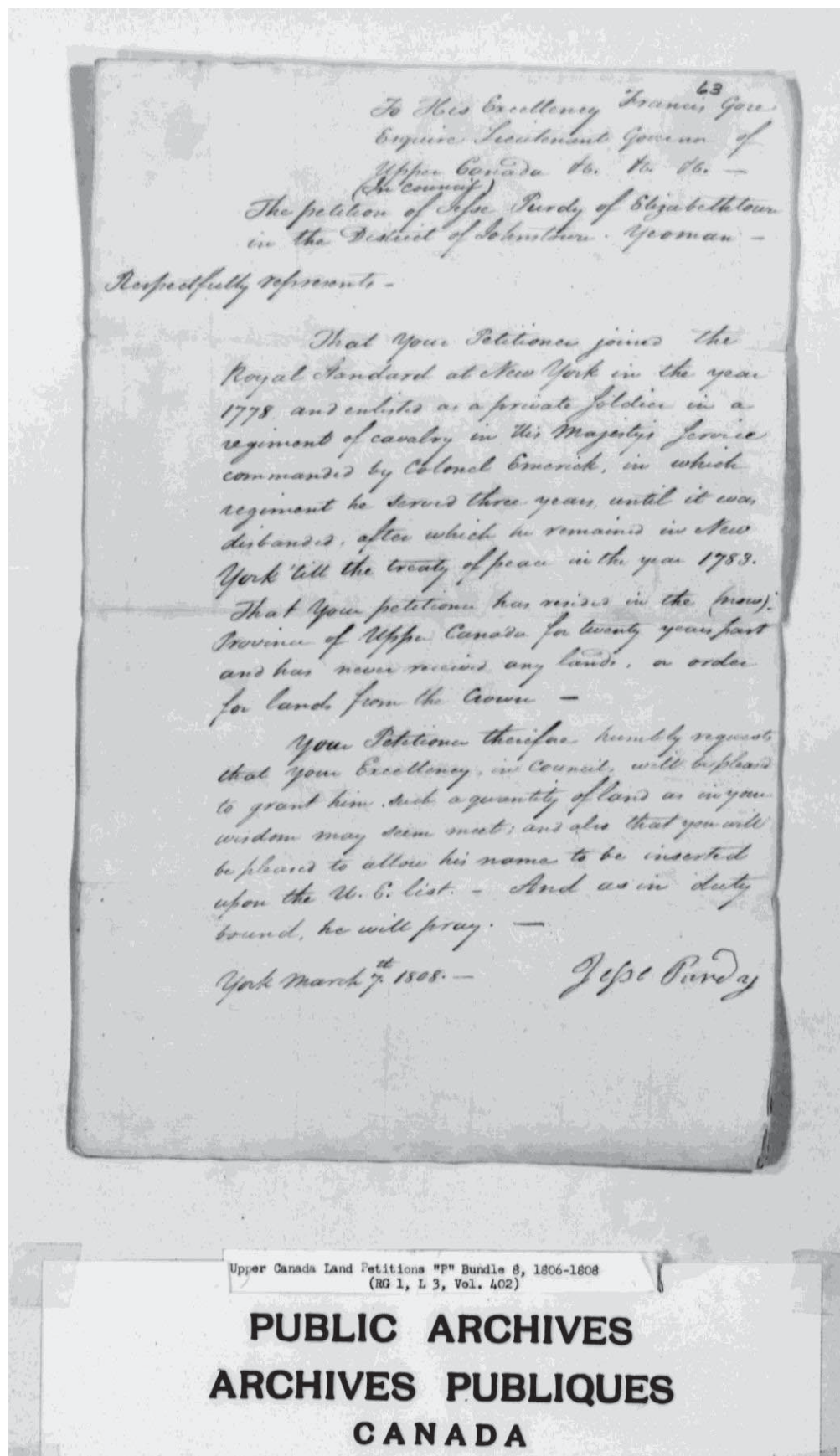

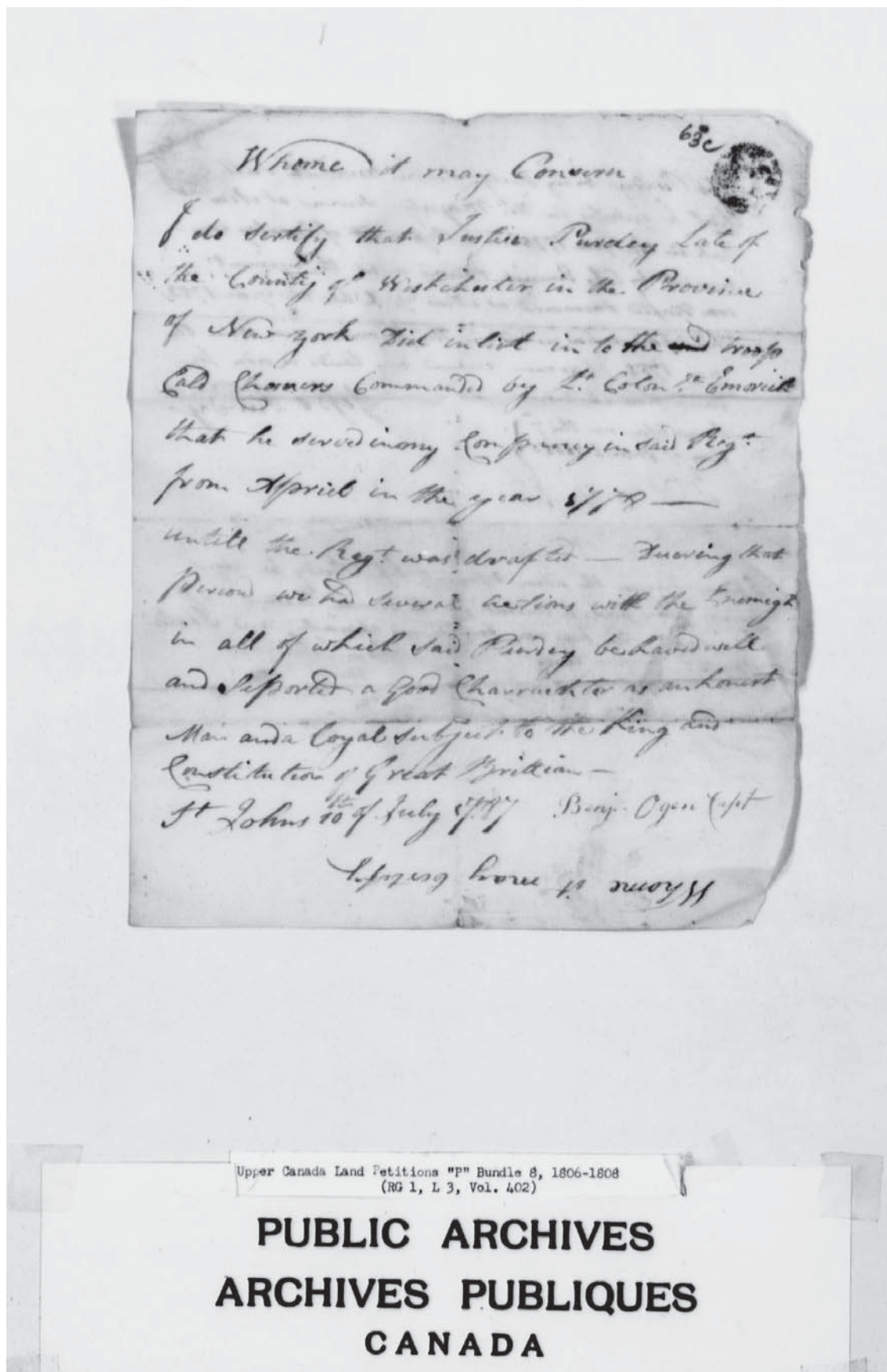
