

L'Abondance Voyage to Port Mouton, N.S.

Left New York Nov. 24, 1783

Disembarked December 23, 1783

"A LIST OF **123 MEN**, **65 WOMEN and children** above the age of ten AND **31 CHILDREN** UNDER TEN YEARS OF AGE, LOYALISTS BORNE AS SUPERNUMERARIES FOR VICTUALS ONLY FOR A PASSAGE FROM NEW YORK TO **PORT MATOON**, NOVA SCOTIA. THE MEN VICTUALLED AT WHOLE ALLOWANCE, THE WOMEN AT TWO THIRDS AND THE CHILDREN AT HALF ALLOWANCE OF ALL SPECIES OF PROVISIONS EXCEPT SPIRITS BY ORDER OF REAR ADMIRAL DIGBY."
